let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation.
- <sup>2</sup>Let us come before him with thanksgiving  
and extol him with music and song.
- <sup>3</sup>For the LORD is the great God,  
the great King above all gods.
- <sup>4</sup>In his hand are the depths of the earth,  
and the mountain peaks belong to him.
- <sup>5</sup>The sea is his, for he made it,  
and his hands formed the dry land.
- <sup>6</sup>Come, let us bow down in worship,  
let us kneel before the LORD our Maker;
- <sup>7</sup>for he is our God
