More Words I Learned last Year

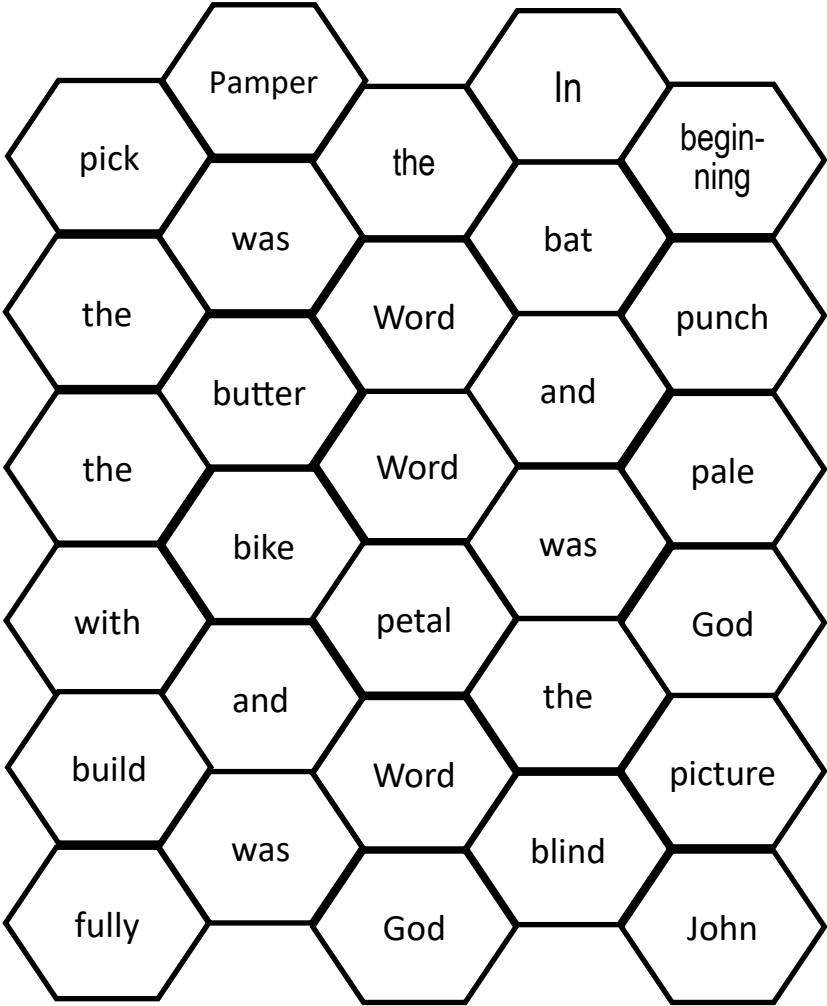
- 1. **Negotiate**---- Obtain or bring about by discussion.
