

And one more thing.....

Thank you for your generosity of spirit and service! I think it is fair to say that we've had some trying times in these 8 months we've shared together as we have sought to serve God and remain faithful to our vision and mission through the ministry at First Christian Church in Montgomery.

Before I say goodbye to you, there is something I think we should all say goodbye to.

<u>Doubt and Fear:</u> Most of the things we do in our lives will be impossible. If you consider that whole birth and birthing process, how is that even realistic? Yet here we are.

The 22 folks who met in Montgomery on March 29, 1908 apparently did not give in to their doubts and fears about the future because they met for 6 years without a building. Yet, here we are. Their first Pastor served not quite a year. The membership dwindled to a few after he left and the second Pastor began serving on April 1, 1911. This is what he found:

Some half-dozen sisters and one brother meeting nearly every Lord's Day to study the Sunday School lesson, in an informal way—but no church, no leaders, no deacons, no communion, and with nearly all the members and friends of the little church against any further efforts that might be made. I knew I had come to the hardest field in the United States. That is why I came! (Christian Standard, November 25, 1911)

Yet, here we are 104 years later!

Clearly, there are things that give us cause for anxiety and concern. I call that life! Growth and understanding are actually fertilized in those moments of uncertainty. Pushing through those moments enable us to know what really matters and who really matters.

Thank you for pushing through, for becoming the church you were truly called to become. Thank you for the hard work of discerning the path God is directing for you. Thank you for stepping up to the plate, owning your faith in Jesus Christ and serving unselfishly.

There is no reason to fear, God is with you, has been with you, will always be with you! All is well, and all will be well!

For several reasons, one of my favorite verses in our sacred texts comes from the First Testament from the book of Isaiah chapter 40 verse 31.

"....those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint."


Door to Door
