Sunday's Message by Pastor Dane: "The Road to the Cross" John 18:1-40

Getting Started (20-30 minutes)

- 1.) Read John 18:1-40 (Last week we focused on vs1-27. This week we'll focus on vs28-40.)
- 2.) Did anything in vs1-27 strike you that you missed last week?
- 3.) When we piece together the four different gospel accounts (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John), it seems clear that Jesus was subjected to 6 different hearings and trials between the time he was arrested and the time he was condemned to die. Read the verses below and write down a few details or reflections about each hearing/trial.
 - a. #1: before Annas (John 18:12-13 &19-24)
 - b. #2: before Caiphas (Matt. 26:57-68 & Mark 14:65)
 - c. #3: before the Sanhedrin (Luke 22:66-71)
 - d. #4: before Pilate (Luke 23:1-5 & John 18:28-38)
 - e. #5: before Herod (Luke 23:6-12)
 - f. #6: before Pilate (Luke 23:13-25)
 - g. Pastor Dane believes that "Each drop of blood, each bruise, each wound <u>adds to the brilliance of</u> <u>the display</u> of God's <u>great love</u> for you and me...and God's <u>great kindness</u> and <u>goodness</u> and <u>compassion</u> and <u>mercy</u> and <u>grace</u>." Do you agree or disagree? Why or why not?

- 4.) Reflect on the sad irony of the Jewish leaders' concern with "ceremonial uncleanness" in John 18:28 when held side-by-side with what they shouted later that morning according to Matthew 27:25?
- 5.) Pilate's question in John 18:38 is a crucial question that every 21st Century Christian should be equipped to answer?
 - a. See John 14:6 What is truth?
 - b. See John 16:13 What is truth?
 - c. See John 8:31-36 What is truth?
 - d. See Ephesians 6:14 What is truth?
 - e. See 1 Timothy 3:15 What is truth?

<u>Digging Deeper</u> (optional. Additional 20 min.)

When the Jewish leaders and soldiers came to arrest Jesus, he asked them, "Who is it you want?" (v4). They responded, "Jesus of Nazareth." But at the end of the chapter, Pilate offered them Jesus, but they refused him: "No, not him! Give us Barabbas!" Write a short gospel presentation (1-2 paragraphs) centered around the question: "Do you want Jesus or not?"
