

From Lisa:

We have now been here for about a week and a half, and things are going very well, all things considered. The other missionaries have been so warm and welcoming, which has made the transition down here go very smoothly. They made meals for us the first few days we were here, and many have stopped by our apartment to welcome us to the mission. The kids are really enjoying getting to know the other kids here at the mission, which is a huge blessing.

Both Jason and I have started in our official roles, and we're both feeling good yet overwhelmed by all there is to learn. Jason is, of course, serving as a Family Physician, including delivering babies. I am working in the administration of both the hospital and the adjoining school.

Things to keep holding us in prayer for:

- that the kids would continue to adjust well and get to know the other kids here at the mission.
- that Jason would adjust to practicing medicine here in this third-world setting.
- that I would learn the details of my new job quickly and without too much stress.
- that the kids would continue to do well with homeschooling (until Ana starts school in the end of October)
- We are currently living in transitional housing (an apartment) and will hopefully be able to move into our more permanent house in about a month. Please pray that our other housing becomes ready quickly, since living out of our suitcases in the small apartment is not ideal.
- that we wouldn't miss home and friends and family too much.
