PURPOSE OF POSITION:

To further the mission and ministry of First Covenant Church by providing leadership and oversight to the Youth and Family Ministries and Worship Team Ministry by incorporating three key priorities:

- Belong: grow in community with peers and trusted adults
- Believe: encounter the love of Jesus in transformational ways
- Become: lifelong followers of Christ bringing Kingdom justice and mercy to the world through the power of the Holy Spirit

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Worship Team Ministry - 20%

- Lead Worship Teams, including running weekly rehearsals, set-up/tear-down and leading worship.
- Recruit volunteers for Worship Teams.
- Participate in weekly Worship Planning meetings and monthly Worship Design meetings.
- Work collaboratively with Worship and Arts ministry team members in meeting the broader goals and purposes within the worship and arts ministry.

Shared Areas of Responsibility - 25%

General

- Schedule worship team practices and work with youth to schedule volunteers to run visuals.
- Oversee transportation needs for youth as they serve in worship ministry areas.
- Participate in all FCC staff meetings, planning, trainings, church-wide key events and initiatives that pertain to living out our mission together.
- Coordinate with children and adult ministries to ensure ministry alignment and synchronization.
- Collaborate with key First Covenant Partners (Family Values for Life, East Side Thrive, Loaves and Fishes, Farnsworth Aerospace School and Johnson Senior High School).

Crisis Care

• Collaborate with ministry team to provide crisis care and support teams for families in critical moments.

Relationship Building

• Develop relationships with youth and parents through youth counseling and attendance at extracurricular activities.

Youth and Family Ministries – 55%

Leadership & Discipleship

- Oversee the Youth + Family Ministry of FCC (includes collaborating on budget, volunteer personnel, room and equipment).
- Create, lead and implement key year-round youth ministry programming (Wednesday Youth Group, Sunday School, Bible Studies, worship experiences and summer camps and/or trips) that help bring youth into relationship with Christ, peers and adults.
- Assist and prepare youth for leadership roles through identification of their gifts, talents and motivations.
- Be an active participant in the Confirmation Program alongside Minister to Youth and Families and Senior Pastor.
- Lead bimonthly meetings of the Youth and Family Ministry Leadership Team.

Planning & Collaboration

Meet weekly with supervisor to plan and pray.

- Work with pastors and other church leaders to foster parent education and support of the parents of adolescents.
- Develop relationships with other youth ministries in the Twin Cities.

Volunteer Recruitment & Training

- Recruit, coach, develop and nurture a diverse group of adult "Youth Mentors" with gifts and talents that contribute to a well run, fully functioning youth ministry.
- Develop and implement youth leadership program.

Communication

 Work in collaboration with the Minister to Youth and Families to develop consistent, effective means of communicating information. Includes: strategic direction, ministry events, ministry needs to youth, parents + broader congregation.

Conference/Denominational Activities

- Attend monthly Northwest Conference Youthworker Connections.
- Attend annual denominational Youthworker Connection.
- Provide information and encourage participation of key youth events, and attend personally. Including: Covenant Pines Bible Camp, MOVE.
