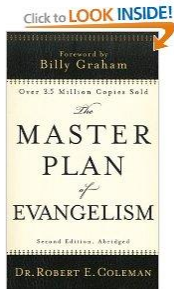
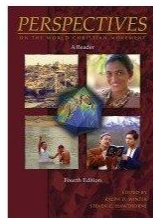

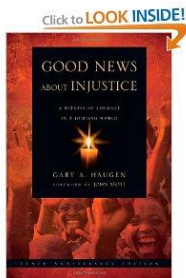
### *Master Plan of Evangelism*, Robert E. Coleman

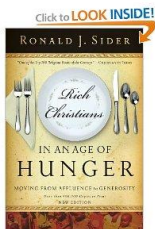
### *Perspectives on the World Christian Movement*, Ralph D. Winter

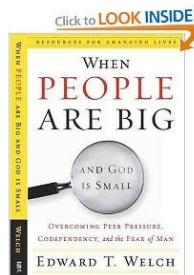
### *Good News About Injustice*, Gary Haugen

This book explains the complex causes of poverty, and then presents practical, workable proposals for change that can be taken up by Christians to apply and follow the teaches of Jesus in the modern world.



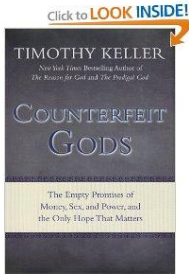

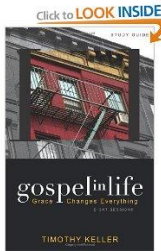

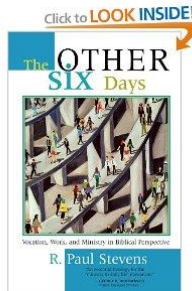


In *Counterfeit Gods*, Keller shows how a proper understanding of the Bible reveals the unvarnished truth about societal ideals and our own hearts.



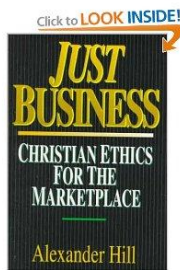
*Gospel in Life*, Tim Keller

Gospel in Life is a study of the gospel and how to live it out in everyday life.



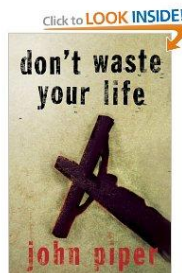
*The Other Six Days*, R. Paul Stevens

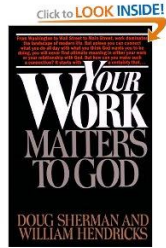


*Don't Waste Your Life*, John Piper

Make your life count for eternity by following Jesus' path to God-exalting joy and purpose by "losing" your life rather than wasting it.

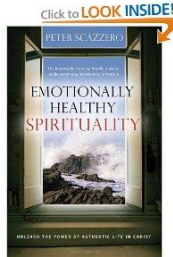

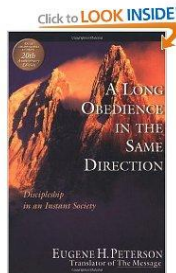
### *Your Work Matters to God*, Doug Sherman

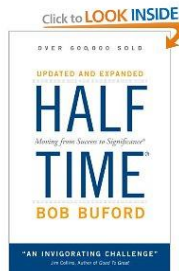
### *Emotionally Healthy Spirituality*, Peter Scazzero

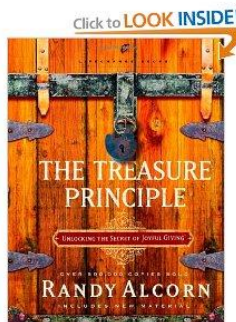


### *A Long Obedience in the Same Direction*, Eugene Peterson
