Active Spiritual Leadership—Jesus Style: Learn how to lead as Jesus did—a "Follow Me" style. You'll learn the importance of character and commitment as well as practical "how-to's" of recruiting, communication, planning, implementing, documenting, and more! At the completion of this 8-week class you will team up and actively apply what you have learned with your own leadership project that will help you develop a personal leadership statement. (Taught by Scott Hamilton)

Basic Training Discipleship Course: This course is a 4-part curriculum that will teach you the basics of how to follow Jesus. BT 101 (taught by Matt Clark) will answer the question, "Why should I believe in Christianity?". Then, as you continue on, BT 102 (taught by Pastor Terry Stark) will answer the question, "How do I develop new habits and feed my new life in Christ?" If you need to learn (or re-learn) the fundamentals of the faith, this class is for you!

Comparative Religions: Are Mormons or Jehovah's Witnesses a sect of Christianity? What about Catholicism and Protestantism and the theological gap between them? What do New-Agers, Buddhists, Muslims and Hindus believe? This will be the focus of this class taught by Pastor Mike and Pastor Terry. Come learn about how Biblical Christianity compares to these and other religions of the world.

Divorce Care: If you are currently or have recently gone through a divorce, this class will help you through the next stage of your life and give you the support that you will need. (Led by Don and Teresa Loops)

Effective Parenting in a Defective World: Raising children is a challenge in today's world. Peers and pop culture exert a never-ending pressure on kids. Often, parents feel helpless when the corrupt principles of this defective world seem to contradict every godly principle they try to instill in their children. But God has a plan for effectively raising your children and you can learn it! This class will be filled with practical ideas and lots of discussion, and it is for parents with kids of all ages! The cost for this class includes a workbook and a practical tool to aid you in disciplining your kids. (Led by Pastor Danny and Sarah Lightner)

Grief Share: If you've recently lost a loved one, this class will help you through the grieving process as you join a support network of people who understand what you are going through. (Led by Donna Maurer)

Making Sense of Life: This class is a verse-by-verse study of the books of Job and Ecclesiastes. These books contain a wealth of God's wisdom in helping you through the trials and frustrations of life, and you'll enjoy opening God's Word and seeking His face in this journey! (Taught by Al Litton)

What Heaven Will Be Like: Have you ever wondered...What is Heaven really going to be like? What will we do? Won't it be boring after a while? If you've always thought of Heaven as a realm of disembodied spirits, clouds, and eternal church services or harp-strumming, you're in for a wonderful surprise. You'll leave this class excited to go there yourself, and you'll be motivated to have loved ones come with you. And maybe for the first time, you'll be able to truly imagine what Heaven will be like.
