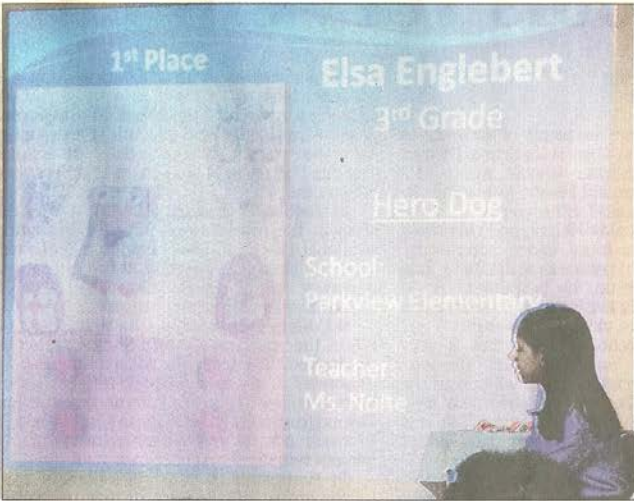


Delta Kappa Gamma Literary Awards 2013
