#### **OUR CHURCH HISTORY**

To show how hard times were for the congregation, a member was elected to attend the Minnesota Conference Convention in 1882, but he had to pay his own expenses. 1n 1885 the parsonage was rented out for \$69 a year. In the same year a student was called to minister for \$500 annually, but he had to pay for living quarters and meals.

In 1884 a student was called to teach parochial school and preach for three months. He was paid \$35 a month to teach four days a week, all day long. Pastor Rast of Sabylund was Vice Pastor. He preached when he could.

Minnieska and Millville were asked to pay what they could toward the pastor's salary. Most years it was nothing, so the Lake City congregation funded all pastorates.

May we take time to remember relatives and friends who served in the military and who gave their lives in defense of our country, our freedoms, and our way of life.
