WHAT'S THE MAIN POINT?

"What is the main point this author wants to make?" Remember that dreaded question back in high school or college? You were put on the spot.

Does life have a main point? It is difficult to know, isn't it?

Maybe the whole world could be thought of as a mobile (object suspended in mid-air by wires). The world acts like a mobile because it can be easily tilted out of balance. We see great changes in the world due to earthquakes, storms, tornadoes, floods and fires. We also see social changes as people strive against abuse and oppression seeking their freedom. We ask, "What is the main cause of each event?" People come up with a myriad of answers Reducing things to a single cause or event is often difficult to do.

If someone asked you, "What is the main point of your life?". Could you answer that question? Or would you come up with a list of interconnected events? Is your life like a mobile, precariously balanced and always a tip away from clattering to the floor?

Life seems to become very complex! Yet it is still possible to reduce things down to a single point. Even the most complex mobile needs to be suspended from a single point on the ceiling.

If we ask, "What is the main point the Bible wants to make?", the answer is relatively simple and it can be summed up by Psalm 119:175, "Let me live that I may praise God, and let his ordinances help me." We were created to praise God and to live with God's Word as our guide. That gives us a great deal of freedom. We can balance many things and we can embrace the complexity of life so long as we remain anchored in our worship life, connected to God and focused on living with God as our guide.

The main point of life is to give God praise, which serves to remind me that a) There is a God, and b) I am not him. When I have those points straight, balancing the mobile of my life becomes tolerable and possible. That is the best argument I can make for why people should come together for worship.

How is your balancing act? What are you anchored to?




