

STEPS TO GENEROUS GIVING


Ask yourself the following questions:

- 1. When you come to First Presbyterian Church of Alexandria, do you expect the lights to be on and the air conditioning to be functioning? Of course you do or you would not come.
- 2. Do you expect to hear good music that will encourage and uplift you? This is a reasonable expectation.
- Should you expect to hear a sermon that will instruct you in the Word of God, give you some truths to live by and feed your soul? Not too much to ask.
- 4. When you go into a Sunday School Class, will there be quality literature for you for the lesson? I would hope so.
- 5. Will there be coffee and donuts for you before the service? After all, that's the way you get ready for the service.
- 6. On Wednesday evenings will there be a meal ready for you at the Fellowship Dinner? I like the idea and expect it to be there for me.
- 7. When we have the mid-week Bible study after the Fellowship meal, can you expect a Bible study with spiritual depth that will help you get through my week? You should settle for no less.
- 8. When you are sick either at home or in the hospital, can you reasonably expect a visit from the pastor to encourage and pray for you? Absolutely
- Would you be upset if the Sanctuary, classrooms, the Fellowship Hall and bathrooms were dirty and messy (with no toilet paper of towels)? Of course you would.
- 10. Do you expect your church to support mission causes at home and around the world? Isn't that what churches do?
- 11. Do you expect to enjoy all these and to feel good about what your church does and for it to cost you nothing or next to nothing?

I do not think this is the way you think. To me, you are showing growth in learning the joy of generous giving. To help you continue to grow, let me ask you to consider the following:

- Have a willing and open mind. Let God guide you. In Exodus 35, only those whose hearts were willing were allowed to participate in the offerings. Their hearts were willing because of what they had seen God do for them.
- 2. Think of the good things your church does with the money. Members of the Session and others who make financial decisions for the church must remember it is still God's money after it is given to the church. If you have concerns or questions about the budget or expenditures, ask and I will do my best to get you an answer. You deserve to know.
- 3. Give cheerfully. "God loves a cheerful giver." (2 Cor. 9:7) God as little pleasure in a gift given with the wrong attitude. He can still honor the gift and create good from it but the giver has lost a blessing.
- Refuse to be pressured. Do not let anyone, including me, pressure you into giving. Let God set the amount, and you will be blessed.


