

FROM THE PASTOR

BE CAREFUL LITTLE LIPS WHAT YOU SAY

These words are directed to me as well as to anyone who chances to read this piece in the newsletter. The Bible warns us to "Be not rash with thy mouth" (Ecc. 5:2). I would do well to take these words to heart as would you.

In 1870 there was a certain bishop who did not heed the advice of the Holy Scripture. The bishop heard an educator say that in fifty years men would "fly like birds." The bishop pontificated with this statement: "Flight is strictly reserved for the angels and I beg you not to repeat your statement lest you be guilty of blasphemy."

Ironically, the mistaken bishop was Milton Wright, the father of Wilbur and Orville Wright. It was only 33 years after the bishop put his foot in his mouth that the Wright brothers made their famous flight. Or in other words "they flew."


