



Her health is, unfortunately, not good and Dr. Heath noted that she is pushing herself to play each Sunday, and she needs our prayers.

Pastor's/Moderator Report: Dr. Jim Heath

- Dr. Heath suggested placing a listing for First Presbyterian Church in the Alexandria Daily Town Talk newspaper. He stated the ad would cost \$11 per week. The Session pointed out that prior efforts with newspaper ads have not been successful, but Dr. Heath felt that many people know him from his teaching at Louisiana College, and it might be an good option to try once more. The Session agreed to a 3-month trial.


