

#### FROM THE PASTOR . . .

In the recent letter sent to all members by the session, all of us could find many reasons to give thanks to God for the good things we have seen happening in our church during 2016.

We must always remember to praise Him from Whom all blessings flow as we sing from the depths of our hearts: "To God Be the Glory, Great Things He Hath Done!"

As we enter into the new year of 2017, we look forward to seeing how God will continue to work in our midst. Isaiah 43:18-19 has the Lord saying these relevant words:

> "Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past.

See, I am doing a new thing!

Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the desert and streams in the wasteland."

In this passage, the Lord is encouraging His people to put the past behind them--and to focus on the new thing that He is doing.






