FROM THE PASTOR . . .

"No, We Are Not All God's Children"

Christian's are so often told, mostly by non-believers, that we are all God's children. This statement is made without any consideration of whether or not a person believes in God, or regardless of whether or not a person accepts Jesus Christ by faith as their Savior in repentance from sin, or His sacrifice for their forgiveness.

But, the Bible completely contradicts this modern notion, where we read in Hebrews 11:6:

"But without faith, it is impossible to please Him. For He that comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them who diligently seek Him."

The fact is that none of us are God's children. The Bible reminds us the hard truth that every human being has a different father, and has no claim to the God of our Lord Jesus as their father at all, as Jesus Himself warned," you are of your father the Devil," John 8:44.

Notice that Jesus pins every one of us down with His accusation in His use of the the second-person personal pronoun "you." He pointedly tells every one of us who is our father. He is the Devil.

Despite the fact that every human being owes their very lives and each breath to the God of Heaven and Earth, He rejects any connection with us unless He specifically adopts us as His children.

Our father the Devil was eager for the death of our Savior on many occasions. He instigated Herod to destroy Christ in His infancy. He tempted Jesus to destroy Himself in the wilderness temptations. He stirred up the Scribes and Pharisees to kill Jesus, and whispered in the heart of Judas to betray Him.

The Devil teaches his children the lie that all of us are actually good, that as long as we are "sincere," then it really doesn't matter what we believe. That, too, is a lie.

Every human being must take to heart what the Apostle John warns:

"He that believes on the Son of God has the witness in Himself. But, the one who does not believe God has made Him a liar, because he does not believe the record that God gave His Son."

Everyone who believes that Jesus is God's Son, and accepts by faith His sacrifice for their sin, has eternal life as a gift of God's grace, as well as being adopted by God as their Father. (See I John 5:1, 2).

Thereby, this is the reason God is not ashamed to be called, our Father.




