

Wynn Ware and Emma Jean Huffman were installed as elders on January 10, 2010.

Easter Services will be observed as follows:

February 17, 2010 Ash Wednesday Service 7:00 pm; April 1, 2010 Maundy Thursday Service 7:00 pm; April 2, 2010 Good Friday Service at Noon; Sunrise Services with The Lutheran Church (time to be announced) on Easter Sunday and regular church services on Easter Sunday at 11:00 am.

Rev. Farrell has ordered the spiritual gift survey forms. She would like to have more weekly bible studies in small groups.

Rev. Farrell did elder training on G1.0100, G.6.002, G.60105 and G.1.0304. A discussion was on the specific responsibilities of Elders. Rev. Farrell gave an overview of the responsibilities of the Session—combination Elder/Deacon. She reminded us that the "Founding Fa-thers" of our country were mostly Presbyterians.

Rev. Farrell is still working on the web-site for the church. This is not an easy task that she has undertaken.

Ladies Morning Circle will meet March 9, 2010. The Health Worx meal will be prepared on March 16<sup>th</sup>. Session will also meet on March 16<sup>th</sup>.
