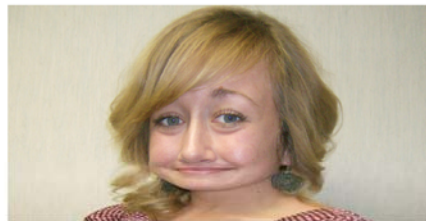
Sarah Floyd
