In our Fall Sermon Series will be exploring the Epistles of John. John's three letters are written to the churches in Asia Minor at the end of the first century, over 50 years after the resurrection of Jesus. John is now in his eighties, the last of the apostles alive and the only one not martyred. The radical proclamation of the Gospel which had turned the world upside down has now become commonplace to the believers. John is deeply concerned about what such apathy is doing to the church. So John writes these letters to combat the false teaching splintering the church, to call the church back to Jesus by confession and obedience, and to encourage them to show deep and radical love to one another. His goal in these letters is that you and I might truly have fellowship with God and with one another. Come join us Sundays this fall as John teaches us how to be the living, breathing embodiment of very Word of Life that we proclaim.
