<u>"FEED MY STARVING CHILDREN" SALINA EVENT</u>: JAN. 17-18TH

The Social Justice & Mission Committee invites you to join in a local event to help pack 175,000 meals through the organization "Feed My Starving Children" (FMSC) Jan. 17-18 in the Hauptli Student Center at Kansas Wesleyan. FMSC is a Christian nonprofit hunger relief organization working with volunteers to produceMannaPack Rice, a scientifically formulated food formula that is culturally acceptable worldwide, and donated to feed children in 70 countries around the world. A total of 800 volunteers will be needed Jan. 17-18 to fill all seven shifts. To sign-up for a 2-hour session (beginning at 12:30 pm on Sunday and ending at 6:30 pm on Monday),

Children (ages 5 and up) are welcome to help if accompanied by an adult. Volunteers are asked to bring a nonperishable food or toiletry item that will be given to local organizations.

REFUGEE SUNDAY: JANUARY 24TH

During Advent, we prayed for those Jesus often served: people on the margins of society, including refugees. We remember that Jesus was a refugee at a very young age when Joseph took Mary and Jesus to Egypt to escape King Herod and his decree. On Sunday, Jan. 24th, the Social Justice and Mission Committee has approved "Refugee Sunday," a day for us to lift up the plight of refugees in our world today. In worship, we will learn more about the refugee crisis, pray for refugees around the world and talk about ways we can make a difference in their lives.
