Sunday RealLife - 10:00 AM




We've got things for your kids... you're already coming... so try out our Sunday RealLife Group at 10:00 AM in the Fellowship Hall.

Backpacks for Hunger

For the third year in a row we are providing backpacks for hungry kids in our community. We started with a modest list of 12 children in one school three years ago, and since then, we have increased that number to 75 children in 3 local schools. Each week we fill a backpack with food for the children to take home with them on Friday - they take it home, bring it back on Monday and we do it again for the following Friday. It is a simple, yet effective way of ministering to a need here in our local community.

You can help by bringing small jars of peanut butter to the church (we put this in every backpack) or new this year... you can "adopt" a backpack by giving \$200 to cover the cost for the school year.
