Administrative Council Meeting Minutes  
June 11, 2013

In lieu of a formal Administrative Council meeting in June, the committee members were encouraged to go out in the community and make home visits. This alternative was chosen to highlight the importance of home visitation. Below are highlights of written reports that were submitted.

- **Approval of Minutes**

Minutes of the April 9, 2013 meeting were not read but copies were emailed to all the members; there was no approval of the minutes.

- **Ministry Perspective**

- **Administrative Reports**

Treasurer's Report – Bill Yeager reported that income and expenses are close to budget projections. To date income is 1.11% over projected income and expenses are 0.37% over projections. The goal at the beginning of the year was to have a balance of \$25,000 in the general fund. To date the total is \$1,795.74.

Communications Committee – Tammy Payton reported that the committee continues to track the usage of the church's website. There were 712 different people who visited the website during a period of about eight weeks. Currently there are 224 subscribers to the electronic newsletter, 293 followers on Twitter and as of June 4<sup>th</sup> there were 183 "likes" on Facebook. Tammy reported that the committee plans to modify the newspaper ad in the Mooresville Times to include the church's street address and phone number. The new electronic sign has been installed and Tammy will be keeping the sign messages updated.

- **Ministry and Missions Reports**

Worship Committee – Jeff Lawson reported that attendance on Mother's Day was very good. The balance of the extra pink compacts that were given out that day was donated to the Pregnancy Care Center. There will be an appreciation service for Testify Band on Sunday, June 9<sup>th</sup> and plans are being made for a special Father's Day worship service.

Missions Committee – Claire Farrand reported that there was a great response to the Jackson Center Walk for Dreams, the UMW Strawberry Festival and Henderson BBQ, the postal worker's food drive for Churches in Mission, Elo Camp for the Ben Elo Foundation and the youth mission trip. The summer lunch program has also kicked off with more than 150 meals served. There

are plans to provide meals for VBS being held at Country Manor Trailer Park this summer. In June there will be a school supply drive for Churches in Mission.

Adult Education – Tammy Payton reported that the main objective for Adult Education is discipleship development. Everyone needs to be reminded that they are all called to disciple another person, not just the pastors. Three areas of discipleship individuals and groups could use to measure their walk as they transform into a follower of Christ are: worship, ministry and mission. The committee is also discussing the programming for Sunday, Wednesday and small groups. One change in the Wednesday schedule is that there will be no meal offered on Wednesdays, unless someone steps up for a “Wednesday Kitchen Ministry.”

Evangelism/Outreach – Steve Klinger reported that several new folks responded to the challenge to join the group on Monday visitations for six weeks. There was positive feedback from those who participated. The daytime visitation folks continue to reach those that are housebound and recovering from illnesses or surgery. There have been some awesome testimonies from several folks this year; personal testimony is powerful. There are fourteen men signed up to attend the Promise Keepers in Nashville, TN the end of June.
