Oct. 1 - Seek first the kingdom of God. Prayer is seeking God. Let us seek Him first today. - Matthew 6:33

Oct. 2 - All things are possible with the Lord. Pray with faith believing that God is able to do all things. - Mark 10:27

Oct. 3 - Be obedient to the Lord by praying. The Lord commands us to pray. - Luke 18:1

Oct. 4 - Hearing from God. Prayer is not only talking to God but listening to Him as well. As you pray open your bible and listen for the voice of God. - Psalm 143:8

Oct. 5 - Draw near to the Lord by calling out to Him with the expectation of Him doing great things. - Jeremiah 33:3

Oct. 6 - Delight yourself in the Lord. As you focus on the Lord, be confident that He will bless you. - Psalm 37:4

Oct. 7 - Lift up a prayer for families, marriages, and relationships for spiritual growth and fruit. - Psalm 128:1-3

Oct. 8 - Prayer for church unity, growth, and for the building up of the body of Christ. - Ephesians 4:12-13

Oct. 9 - Set your mind on things above. Pray for the ministry at FUMC - that the staff, leaders, volunteers, and the board of trustees would serve with an eternal perspective. - Colossians 3:1-2

Oct. 10 - Pray for our congregation that we would passionately pursue the will of the Lord in all we say and do. - Colossians 3:17

Oct. 11 - Asking God for opportunities. Pray for open doors to share the gospel. - Colossians 4:3

Oct. 12 - Pray for forgiveness. Pray for change in aspects of your life that could hinder your walk with the Lord. - Ephesians 4:32

Oct. 13 - Pray for the peace of God in your heart that you may abide in Him. Jesus says, "Peace I give to you." - Colossians 3:15

Oct. 14 - In everything give thanks. Take a moment to thank God for the many blessing in your life. - 1 Thessalonians 5:18

Oct. 15 - Pray to be filled with the Holy Spirit. - Acts 1:8

Oct. 16 - Pray for Gods protection and strength as you reach out to others.

Oct. 17 - Ask for God's provision. He will supply all your needs. - Philippians 4:19

Oct. 24 - Ask God to fill you up with more of Him. Whoever hungers after God shall be filled. - Matthew 5:6

Oct. 25 - Birth of Christ. Praise the One who came to seek and save the lost.

Oct. 26 - Be a light unto others. Pray that your actions and words would shine light in the dark places. - Matthew 5:16

Oct. 27 - Pray for comfort in suffering. God comforts us so that we may comfort others. - 2 Corinthians 1:3-5

Oct. 28 - Adoration. During your prayer praise Him, adore Him, and bow down before Him. Give Him glory for He is good. - Psalm 95:6

Oct. 29 - Let your faith be evident. Ask that your life demonstrates the fruits of the spirit. - Galatians 5:22-23

Oct. 30 - Perseverance in prayer. Continue in prayer that you may develop a habit in prayer. - Luke 18:1-5
