

GED Classes Offered at 1st UMC - In addition to providing support to the Adult Basic Education Foundation, two General Equivalency Diploma (GED) classes meet regularly at our facility.

One class is a math course for adults, designed for those who are pursuing the required Math portion of the GED and those students that are either attending a certified nursing program or planning to enroll in a program and need to improve math skills.

The second is designed for 17-18 year old young adults who have been removed from the public school system for a variety of different reasons. The students in this program are actively pursuing the GED and it includes daily studies and assignments in math, reading and English/essay. Every effort is being made to help these young people transition into adulthood.
