Your patterns matter. An education arises page by page. Fitness builds step after step. Health increases healthy meal by meal. Friendship grows kindness after kindness. On Tuesday, Doug, Elmo, Esther, Jeff, Julie, Mandy, Rosemary, and I spent the morning in an in-house retreat, prayerfully conversing around how to do ministry in our increasingly busy, less-committed, and ever more secular culture. At the 2016 Tennessee Annual Conference, our delegates voted to authorize moving from seven TAC districts to five. The new district boundaries are drawn with geographic and missional intentionality. The Old Murfreesboro District is now in the Stones River District, and will be led by a skilled veteran District Superintendent, **Rev. Max Mayo**.
