**The Message—Pastor Rick Wade**

The writer of Hebrews tells us, “Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen” (v. 11:1), which implies confidence in more than we can touch, see, hear, or even know. Faith calls us to move outside our comfort zone to something more, something powerful, and at times, beyond reason. We often hear Jesus say to those with an incurable disease, “your faith has made you well” (see Saint Matthew 9:22).

Seeing such miraculous power in faith, the apostles said to Jesus, “Increase our faith!” And the Lord said, “If you had faith like a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, ‘Be uprooted and be planted in the sea’; and it would obey you” (Saint Luke 17:5-6). Could it be that what Jesus is really saying to the apostles is, do more than wish for good to happen, work to make it so? It could be that Jesus is saying to those listening (including us) if you want the mulberry tree to move, show up with a shovel in your hands. Faith is more than hoping good things (God size things) will happen; it is mixing hope with action, believing it will happen.

To this end, James says, “What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if someone claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith save them? Suppose a brother or a sister is without clothes and daily food. If one of you says to them, ‘Go in peace; keep warm and well fed,’ but does nothing about their physical needs, what good is it? In the same way, faith by itself, if not accompanied by action, is dead” (vv. 2:14-17). Our faith then is not faith in what we can do, it is faith in what God can do working through us. You and I are the people of God, called to this time and place to preach the saving message of God’s grace, and to exemplify that grace to all we meet. I praise God for the opportunity to serve Tullahoma First UMC; and, I am excited to live out our faith together in the name of Christ!


