

**The Message—Pastor Rickey Wade**

**Things of God**

I enjoy a great many stories of the Bible. Among my favorites is the story of Peter and the apostles before the council shortly after the Day of Pentecost. As the story goes Peter and others had been teaching the faith and for this they had been threatened, beaten, and imprisoned. Nonetheless, they continued to witness for the faith. On one such occasion Scripture says that Peter and the others again found themselves before the council, and this time the council was determined to do away with them – I assume the intent was to have them killed. However, a man of reason among the council stands and asks to be heard. Here is how that went:

“But a certain Pharisee named Gamaliel, a teacher of the Law, respected by all the people, stood up in the Council and gave orders to put the men outside for a short time. And he said to them, ‘Men of Israel, take care what you propose to do with these men. For some time ago Theudas rose up, claiming to be somebody; and a group of about four hundred men joined up with him. And he was slain; and all who followed him were dispersed and came to nothing. After this man Judas of Galilee rose up in the days of the census, and drew away some people after him, he too perished, and all those who followed him were scattered. And so in the present case, I say to you, stay away from these men and let them alone, for if this plan or action should be of men, it will be overthrown; but if it is of God, you will not be able to overthrow them; or else you may even be found fighting against God’” (Acts 5:34-39).

I often think of this story, especially when the Church is making some great plan or developing a great new program. In my time with the Church I have seen many programs come and go. Don’t get me wrong, planning and programing is good, even essential. Just the same, we seem to spend a great deal of time trying to persuade and entice folks into a relationship with Jesus. As I look back over history many, many programs to do just that have come and gone, but for almost twenty centuries one method has stood the test of time.

Jesus simply loved people, cared for people, healed people, taught people, and was honest with people – then he said to them, “Come and follow me.” Something powerful happens when the world sees ordinary, simple, and honest folks loving others and following Jesus. I believe that is what the world needs to see in us.


