By Profession of Faith and Baptism

If you have never joined a church before, we will receive you by profession of faith. By Transfer From Another Denomination

If you have been baptized, we recognize your baptism and profession of faith from your previous Denomination/Church. We believe that you coming to join First United Methodist Church of Childress is a statement of renewal of your faith in Jesus Christ. We will ask you to be loyal to the United Methodist Church and uphold it by your prayers, your presence, your gifts, your service, and your witness. Your answer to this question is "I will." We will notify your previous church of your decision to unite with First United Methodist Church of Childress.

By Transfer from Another United Methodist Church

We are happy to receive you by transfer from another United Methodist Church. We believe that you coming to unite with First United Methodist Church of Childress is in itself a statement of renewal of your faith and commitment to Christ and the Church. We will notify your previous church of your decision to unite with First United Methodist Church of Childress.

By Affiliate or Associate Membership

Any United Methodist living in the Childress area for an extended period of time may become an affiliate or associate member. This membership enables you to retain your membership in your home church and at the same time be a part of ours.

Basics of Christian Faith and Discipline

1. What is a Christian?

A Christian is a person who believes that the living God is revealed in and through Jesus Christ, who accepts Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, who lives in obedient communion with God through the power of the Holy Spirit, and who takes his or her place in the community of Christ's church. (Acts 11:26; John 14:8-11; John 1:1-5, 14-18, Hebrews 1:1-3)

2. What is the good news (gospel/evangel)?

The good news is that God has acted decisively and uniquely in Jesus Christ to deal with our sinful condition. God has acted to save us by offering us love, grace, forgiveness, acceptance, and new life in Christ. (John 3:16-17; Acts10:36-43; Il Corinthians 5:17)

3. What is salvation?

Salvation is the forgiveness of our sin, deliverance from bondage, and the gift of new life in Christ. It is a process that begins now, gives victory over sin and death, and is completed with God in heaven. (Mark 2:1-4; 10:28-31, 45; Romans 5:15-21; Il Corinthians 5:18-21)

4. What is the Invitation to Christian Discipleship?

All people are invited by God to repent of their sin, to trust and follow Jesus Christ, to learn form his words and deeds, and to share in his mission, through the power of the Holy Spirit and in company with other Christians. (Mark 1:16-20, 3:13-15; John 20:21-22; Acts 1:8)

5. Who is welcome as a member of the United Methodist Church?

All people who confess Jesus Christ as Lord and savior and who accept the challenge to serve him in the life of the church and the world are welcome as full members. If not already baptized, those seeking membership may be baptized before being received as full members.
