MINISTRY DESCRIPTION



Bible Verse: Jesus said, "If you continue in my word, you are truly my disciples; and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free." (John 8: 31)

<u>Objective</u>: Liturgists help FUPC to glorify God through faithful service and meaningful worship, by preparing and presenting liturgy for both worship services and by helping to create a significant worship environment and experience for those in attendance.

Result #1: Liturgists understand the order of worship and are able to follow it independently; they know that typically liturgists lead worship at the beginning of the services, but the pastor takes the lead after the scripture reading.

Result #2: Liturgists receive a PDF of the bulletin via email or pick up a paper copy of the bulletin on Friday afternoon; they then review the bulletin to practice all readings, such as the scripture passages for the week (NRSV).

Result #3: Liturgists contribute by writing original content to include in the leadership of the service.

Result #4: Liturgists arrive at the church no later than 20 minutes before the service, to allow time for the pastor to coordinate any last details.

Result #5: Liturgists enter and exit worship services with the pastor.

Team Composition (number): 12-15 volunteers

<u>Time Commitment:</u> 4 to 5 hours, approximately once every three months (Special worship services or holiday observation services do occur, which might add infrequently to the time commitment.)

<u>Special Talents and Skills Preferred:</u> Interest in worship service; clear enunciation; fluent reader (aloud); some familiarity with scripture reading and study; comfort with public speaking.

Spiritual Gifts: Discernment, Teaching, Knowledge.

Support and Accountability: Senior Pastor

Resources and Training Provided: The pastor provides printed materials, as well as information to access websites and his own specific instructions for worship.

Requirement: Member of FUPC
