Result #1: Learns and performs assigned music under the direction of the church Music Director.

Team Composition (number): 13-15 people

Time Commitment: Weekly rehearsals on Thursday from 6:00pm to 6:45pm, August through May; Perform at 10:30am worship service once every 5 to 6 weeks.

Special Talents and Skills Preferred: Basic music literacy and a willingness to learn. People with no prior experience can learn “on the job”.

Spiritual Gifts: Organization, Faith, Serving.

Support and Accountability: *FUPC Music Director.*

Resources and Training Provided: On the job training through rehearsal and performance. Bells, music and other materials required will be provided.

Requirement: FUPC membership is not a requirement to participate in the United Bells.
