FCS was one of 40 private schools that participated in the 2011 SCISA Music Festival held in Columbia, Thursday, March 10th. One thousand participants statewide performed before a team of judges from USC's School of Music.

We sent 140 students from 4th-12th grades to perform in categories of Elementary Choir and Ensemble, Middle School Ensemble, and High School Choir and Ensemble. Under the direction of **Mrs. Evans**, all the vocal choirs and ensembles received a superior rating. Performances were rated in three categories: superior, gold medal; excellent, silver medal; and good, bronze medal.

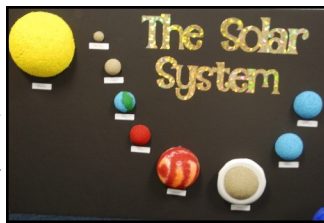
The Third Grade combined art and math in their "Fraction/Fish" project. Students cut paper pieces into fractions and then created a colorful fish scene using the fraction pieces.

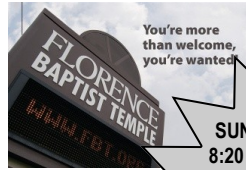
