In addition to the overnight facilities, the Mac Smith Resource Center is a great resource center for anyone interested in further study.

Narrow Ridge is a non-profit organization established to study, teach and demonstrate sustainability. It is dedicated to providing experiential learning of Earth Literacy based on the cornerstones of spirituality, sustainability and community. They are proud to have been “off the grid” since 1991.

LEADERSHIP?

Martha Pierce, Director of Riverside Retreat, will be leading the trip. Her 11 years of camp and retreat ministry experience enable her to facilitate groups of all sizes and ages. She will be joined by a staff of 3 other adults.
