### A NOTE FROM PASTOR DENNIS

This week I am beginning a 4-part sermon series on the book of Esther. Esther is one of the most well-known people in all the Bible. Her story is told and re-told from the earliest years of children's Sabbath School. The plot is intriguing. The evil Hamaan conspires to carry out a Holocaust of all the Jews living in Persia in 480 B.C. Through a series of seemingly coincidental events, his plot is uncovered by Mordecai, a Jew who works in the king's court. Simultaneously, the queen of Persia, Vashti, refuses her husbands command to display her beauty in public and in doing so enrages the king and results in her being deposed. The search for a new queen results in Mordecai's cousin, Esther, winning a beauty pageant and becoming the new queen of Persia. Mordecai persuades Esther to use her overnight status leap to request the king of Persia to overturn Hamaan's plot to destroy the Jews. Esther demonstrates incredible courage in risking her life to save her people and the result is that the evil conspirator is ultimately hung on the gallows that he erected for Mordecai.

The story of Esther is intriguing due to its overarching theme of peripety, which is a literary term for reversal of destiny. The Esther story is about an event intended to harm the Jews, which, against all expectation, actually results in the opposite. Instead of being destroyed, the Jews are not only delivered but empowered through Esther and Mordecai. The empowered destroyer, Haman, not only loses his power but is himself destroyed. This theme of reversal of destiny is interwoven throughout the story.

The Esther story also teaches us several important theological points. The name of God is entirely absent from the story. On the surface, it appears that God is completely uninvolved. Yet, the message is that while God is not explicitly present, he is very much in charge of everything taking place. The story of Esther suggests that beneath the surface of even seemingly insignificant human decisions and events, an unseen and uncontrollable power is at work that can be neither explained nor thwarted. This unseen power is none other than God. The great paradox of Esther is that God is omnipotently present even where God is most conspicuously absent.

I'm looking forward to unfolding this well-known story over the coming weeks as we see how this 2,500 year old story has incredible relevance for our lives today.

- Study reflection/discussion following the sermon


Who is **Sunnyside *Light*** for?
