

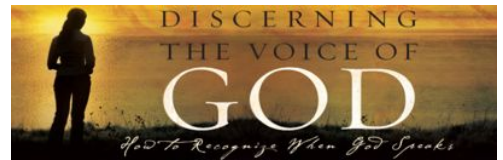

HEALTHY BYTES



The Simple Science of Sugars One of the biggest problems with excess sugar is that it taxes your child's pancreas to produce extra insulin to shuttle the extra sugar around in the body. If your child's pancreas is constantly having to produce inordinate amounts of insulin, something called "pancreatic poop-out" can occur; aka DIABETE. Your child could then be put on insulin shots to help support what the pancreas can no longer do on it's own. So, don't be a "Pancreas Pooper", find healthier choices for your children and reduce the amount of extra sugar that they consume on a daily basis! They'll be healthier and live longer, more productive lives. Then you as a parent, would have done a great job of nurturing and growing a healthy eater!

What are "extra" sugars? Any sugar that is added to food as a preservative or sweetener. Foods that are naturally sweet are in the whole food form. It is very difficult to get too much sugar when eating the whole, unprocessed food.

CHURCH FINANCE 201 - "BENEFITS OF GIVING"¹¹

(No.3 IN A SERIES)

Sunnyside would like to help our church family understand church finances. In an effort to accomplish this, we are publishing a series of brief outlines about how your donations are accounted for and used. This is the third in a series.

Almost since the church was founded, Sabbath Schools have been established in our churches for our children and adults. Sabbath School offerings are taken in each of the children's divisions each Sabbath giving opportunity for our children to establish the habit of systematic giving to the church. These offerings are kept in trust by our local church and sent to the World Church each month, for use in the church's worldwide gospel mission.

The Sabbath School offerings are combined with World Mission offerings and used by the World Church as a funding source for foreign mission projects. This would include construction of mission schools, mission churches, clinics, etc. outside of the United States. If you have been a member of the SDA church for any length of time, the old Mission Spotlight presentations outlined uses of the Sabbath School offerings. Absolutely none of the Sabbath School offerings are used by our local church. It is all sent to the Conference for worldwide use.

The following table shows the last two calendar years' donations to Sabbath School offerings:
