HEALTHY BYTES

Gluten Free Crusty Bread

This is my new favorite bread recipe. If you have a bread machine with a GF setting, it makes this bread really nice.

In bread machine pan, in this order:

- 1 3/4 c lukewarm water or milk
- 1 t cider vinegar
- 1 T honey or sugar
- 1/2 t salt
- 1/3 c vegetable oil or melted butter
- 2 egg plus 1 egg white, lightly beaten
- 400 g Crusty Bread Mix (usually can buy in bulk from health food stores)
- 100 g sourghum flour
- 2 1/4 t active dry yeast
- 2 T chia seeds

Set machine to GF setting, dark crust. Start bread maker. After a couple minutes scrape down sides of pan. (If you miss this step, no worries, you will just have some dry flour on the outside of your bread). As soon as the cycle is finished turn out to cool. It is so good at this stage - yum warm fresh homemade bread! But if you can wait, it cuts easier and looks better if cut when cool.

There is a packaged "Crusty Bread Mix" at the supermarket that is quite expensive. If you can find it in bulk it costs about 50 cents per loaf to make. This is substantial savings and tastes even better with the alterations in this recipe.

Packaged Crusty Bread Mix ingredients: maize flour, rice starch, tapioca starch, soy protein, egg white, sugar, salt, stabilizers, dextrose, emulsifier, guar gum.
