HEALTHY BYTES



We all have cravings from time to time. If you know what is causing those cravings maybe you can give your body what it really wants instead of the junk.

When you crave chocolate you are needing magnesium; eat nuts, seeds, veggies and fruits instead. When you crave sugary foods your body is really wanting chromium (broccoli, grapes, fresh fruits); carbon (fresh fruits); phosphorus (chicken, beef, fatty fish, eggs, dairy, nuts, veggies and grains); sulphur (cranberries, horseradish, cabbage, cauliflower); and tryptophan (raisins, sweet potatoes, spinach). Have a craving for bread, pasta & other carbs? Grab some nitrogen with high protein foods: fatty fish, nuts, beans, and chia seeds. Want oily foods? You need calcium! Eat your green leafy vegetables (preferably not fried!). When you just gotta have salty foods your body really wants chloride (fatty fish, goat milk); and silicon (cashews, nuts, and seeds).

So go ahead - give your body what it wants!
