The Goal Of This Series: Help students see that God invites us into a relationship with him that calls us out of fear and allowing fear to rule our lives.

Week #2: Freedom From Fear with a BIG God

This week we wanted students to see that freedom from fear does not come from within yourself but through your relationship with God. God is big and in control of all things, carrying authority in all things. Yet he yields this power with great love and compassion. In knowing and being with this God we rest and are not afraid of anything.

The Key Passages: Joshua 1:9, Psalm 118:6-8, Revelation 1:9-18, Exodus 34:4-9

Exercise With Your Student:

This week we are simply asking you to do two things:

- 1) Listen to the message online
- 2) Share with your student: What is it about God and his character that helps you to trust him and not be afraid?

Other Possible Discussion Questions:

- 1) How do you try to free yourself from fear and find courage apart from God?
- 2) When you read about what God is truly like, how do you react want to react to him? (fear, disbelief, awe, confused, overwhelmed, peace, etc)
- 3) How could we as a family keep the reality of Jesus and what he is like more in the forefront of our minds?
- 4) How sure are you that God is with you and you are with him? How can we build or deepend our assurance in our relationship with God and his protection/leadership in our lives?
