In 1880 Thomas Edison crafted a strand of electric bulbs and decorated his lab with them and said "Merry Christmas." Two years later, Edward H. Johnson, Edison's business partner, took the next step when he wired an 80 bulb strand of red, white and blue light bulbs that would then dangle on his Christmas tree. So began the Christmas light business which is now a 6 billion dollar a year enterprise.

### Making Room for Others—Campaign Update


