

Ephesians 4:17-20, "This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk, **in the futility of their mind**, 18 having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart; 19 who, **being past feeling**, have given themselves over to lewdness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. 20 But you have not so learned Christ" NKJV

James 1:14-15, “But each one is tempted when he is drawn away **by his own desires and enticed.** 15 Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death” NKJV

Mark 7:20-23, "And He said, "What comes out of a man, that defiles a man. 21 For from within, **out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts,** adulteries, fornications, murders, 22 thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lewdness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness. 23 All **these evil things** **come from within** and defile a man."
