We hope it will be finished in December, just in time for the new high school students who will start in January. The team from **Grace Bible Church** of Bozeman, Montana had a great trip to Zambia in January and February. During their two week mission trip they taught, “How To Study The Bible For Yourself” to our 19 high school students. Each student received their own copy of the book, in addition to a demonstration on how to use the resources in the library. The Montana team also held a Vacation Bible School for the children at Global Samaritans and surrounding villages. More than 120 children came from the villages to be a part of VBS!

We must also thank the Montana team for their dedication to our construction projects! This group has faithfully sent mission groups to the Children’s Home since our initial inception and construction. During their most recent trip to Zambia they were able to complete the following:

- A new hot water heater for houseparents Francesca and Betty
- Hinges and latches on the church/activity center
- Repaired the roof on the guesthouse
- Repaired plumbing in the guesthouse
- Put up a new basketball goal and net
- Put up the steel mainframe for a three-car shelter for our vehicles.

Please be in prayer for the five teams traveling to Global Samaritans during the summer of 2009. They will be ministering at the orphanage and in approximately ten villages nearby. **Drs. Bo and Ruby Cheves**, along with **Dr. Bob Cannon**, will be leading a medical team with eleven nurses and nursing students. We know the Zimba hospital and surrounding villages will be very appreciative to have the medical clinics.

As you can see, exciting things are happening at Global Samaritans and we invite you to be a part of it. We are growing both in numbers and infrastructure and we are looking forward to
