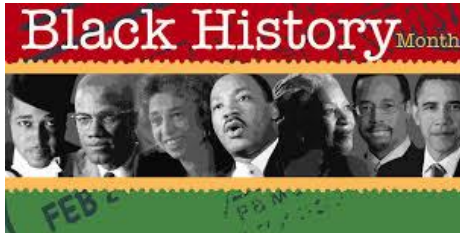

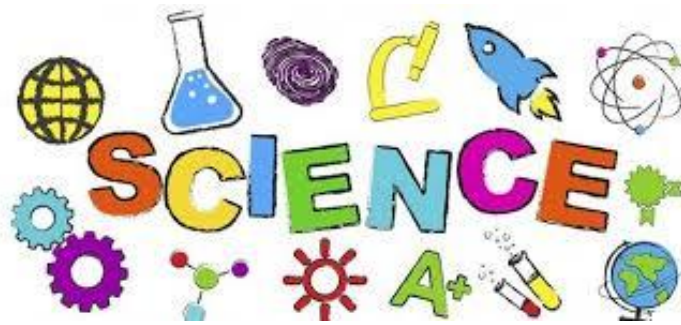
Mission of the Quarter
