

The Chapel Offerings for our fourth and final quarter of the school year are designated for "Showering Love". This organization is a non-profit that provides mobile showers, new undergarments, socks, and hygiene travel kits and other supportive services for people who are experiencing homelessness.

How do they do it? "Grace," as she is affectionately known, is a 44 foot former Miami City Bus that has been converted into a completely self-contained mobile shower transformative platform equipped with 2 private showers (1 of which is ADA compliant) restroom facilities. Grace also has a handicap lift on the side, so no one gets turned away. Showering Love meets Guests where they are, and partners with churches, universities, government agencies, law enforcement, hair stylists, barbers, meal sharing programs and other non-profits to serve the community. When Grace pulls up, and her doors open, Guests, volunteers and partners are physically, emotionally and spiritually transformed and lives are renewed via the Showering Love experience!
