The Authority of Jesus

When I was coaching a junior rugby team a few years back, I had one kid who proved to be quite a challenge. He was a great rugby player, but would not listen to me or follow my basic instructions. It ended up being quite a disruption to the rest of the team and despite my best efforts, nothing seemed to change his behaviour. That all changed one day when his dad turned up to watch training. He behaved perfectly! Why? Because I never had authority in this kid's eyes but his dad did.

In life, I believe, we are always submitting ourselves to authority. Whether self-authority, or the authority of others. For Christians, the call is to submit ourselves to the authority of Jesus. In Mark's Gospel, the writer undoubtedly wants us to know Jesus has authority.

In today's reading (Mark 9:2-9) we see that Jesus' interesting encounter between Jesus and his key team members, Peter, James and John. They go up a mountain and Jesus' appearance changes and God's voice speaks, affirming Jesus' authority. The voice says, "This is my Son, the beloved; listen to him"(v.7).

Jesus' authority was confirmed by God the Father. For Peter, James and John the question now is, "Will they listen to Jesus?" That is, will they submit to Jesus' authority over their lives? In the same way, every person who takes Jesus seriously needs to ask themselves, "Will I listen to Jesus?" "Will I submit to his authority?"
