Classes

Littlest Lambs:

Must be age 1 by 8/1/13

This class focuses on socialization and interaction. Children will become familiar with a daily schedule that includes art, music, movement and play.

9:15 a.m. – 3:15 p.m.

Lambs:

Must be age 2 by 8/1/13

This class is the first step in your child's preschool experience and will prepare them for a more structured environment next year. Activities are developmentally appropriate and include art, music and learning centers. See extended day options.

9:15-11:45 a.m.

Sheep Classes:

Must be age 3 by 8/1/13 and potty trained.

The focus of this class is socialization and preparing children academically. We will introduce letters, numbers and work on fine motor skills to promote reading and writing. See extended day options.

Kindergarten Prep:

Must be age 4 by 8/1/13

Our Kindergarten Prep classes are designed to prepare your child for Kindergarten. This includes letter and number activities, creative art, music classes and field trips. See extended day options.
