

## JUMMP PERSONAL CHECKLIST



Our dress code for JUMMP is strictly enforced and it is important to ***pack only appropriate attire for this mission trip***. You will be serving people who may not understand “youth culture” and will be receiving you as a guest into their homes and churches. This dress code ensures that you, your church and JUMMP will be represented safely and appropriately. **The JUMMP dress code is upheld at all times during JUMMP (work sites, recreation and base camp).**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Bible & Pen
- \_\_\_\_\_ Sleeping Bag and/or cot or air mattress—**TWIN SIZE ONLY (NO DOUBLES)**, sheets, blanket
- \_\_\_\_\_ Pillow
- \_\_\_\_\_ Toilet Articles (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, etc.)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Medications (**ALL medications** must listed on release form, be in their original container and placed in a ziplock bag to turn into the Church representative on Monday at loading.)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Towels (Shower and Swim)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Tote Bag for carrying clothes to showers
- \_\_\_\_\_ Large plastic bag for dirty clothes
- \_\_\_\_\_ Sandals or Flip Flops for Showers
- \_\_\_\_\_ Flashlight
- \_\_\_\_\_ Work Clothes for everyday (3 work days—clothes that can be replaced if necessary (i.e. paint, etc.))
  - Socks & underwear
  - Shorts of modest length (no low-rise shorts); must have a minimum of 4” inseam length
  - T-Shirts (only tops with sleeves— no tank tops, halters, or cut-off sleeves)  
*shirts must cover shoulders, stomach and back*
  - Shoes - Hard Soles - SANDALS CANNOT be worn at work sites
  - One Pair of Jeans** (in case needed for specific work task—may get messy)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Personal Tool Kit for work sites (*work gloves, paint brush & safety glasses are required*)
  - work gloves**
  - paint brushes** (Various sizes)
  - safety glasses
  - wire brush
  - hammer
  - paint scraper
- \_\_\_\_\_ Cap
- \_\_\_\_\_ Sunglasses
- \_\_\_\_\_ Swimsuit (**ONE PIECE**, conservative & modest — **NO BIKINIS**)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Casual Clothes for evenings (5 days)
  - Shorts (no low-rise shorts); must have a minimum of 4” inseam length
  - Pants (no low-rise)
  - T-shirts with sleeves only (no tank tops, halters, or cut-off sleeves)
  - NO dresses or tank tops
  - Sweatshirt/Sweatpants (sometimes the churches where we stay can get very cold—especially at night)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Tennis Shoes
- \_\_\_\_\_ Sunscreen (SPF 30 or Higher – NOT oil)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Insect Repellent
- \_\_\_\_\_ Quarters for Coke Machine
- \_\_\_\_\_ Camera (not your cell phone)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Spending money for treats during the week and for meals traveling to and from camp
