JUMMP MODEL:

MISSION STATEMENT: Developing Jr. High youth as Servant Leaders

The <u>JUMMP VISION</u> is Junior High youth and adults coming together as disciples of Jesus Christ, in servanthood through an annual weeklong mission project, witnessing God change lives.

MISSION WORK: painting, yard work, house cleaning, screening doors/windows, weather stripping, roofing, wheel chair ramps, other general household repairs

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT: youth will work as a member of a work team; serve in different leadership roles within that work team: Team Leader, Safety Leader, Encourager, Devotion Leader, Tool Leader; serve in base camp jobs (serving food, cleaning, etc.)

SPIRITUAL GROWTH: morning and evening devotions/worship, work-site lunch time devotions

CAMP DETAILS/HIGHLIGHTS:

2013 Theme: "He Did It"

Work Teams: will consist of 5 GSUMC youth and 1 GSUMC adult. Work teams will be selected by Jeff.

GENERAL SCHEDULE:

Monday: Arrive, check in, visit client sites, Rotations, dinner, opening worship

Tuesday-Thursday:

- Morning Devotion/worship
- Breakfast
- Work on client homes (morning through mid-afternoon). BRING CLOTHES THAT CAN BE REPLACED!
- Lunch and lunch time devotional on client site (with client)
- Showers offsite, then return to Base Camp
- Evening activities (games, water night, Client Night)
- Dinner
- Evening worship (youth planned and led)

Friday: Breakfast, clean-up, closing worship, home
