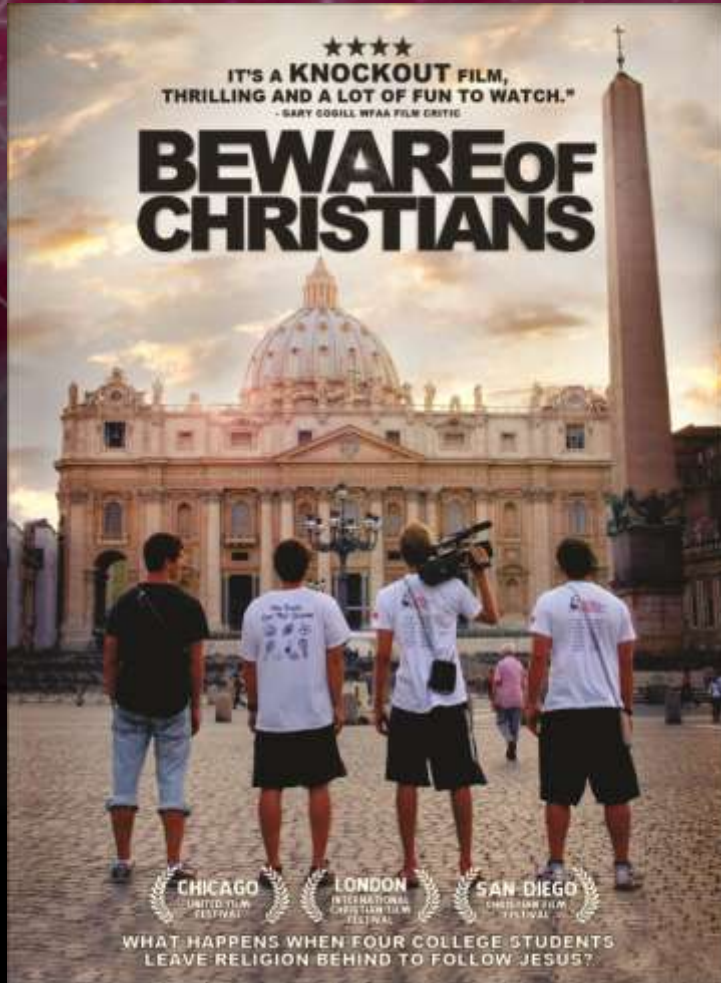

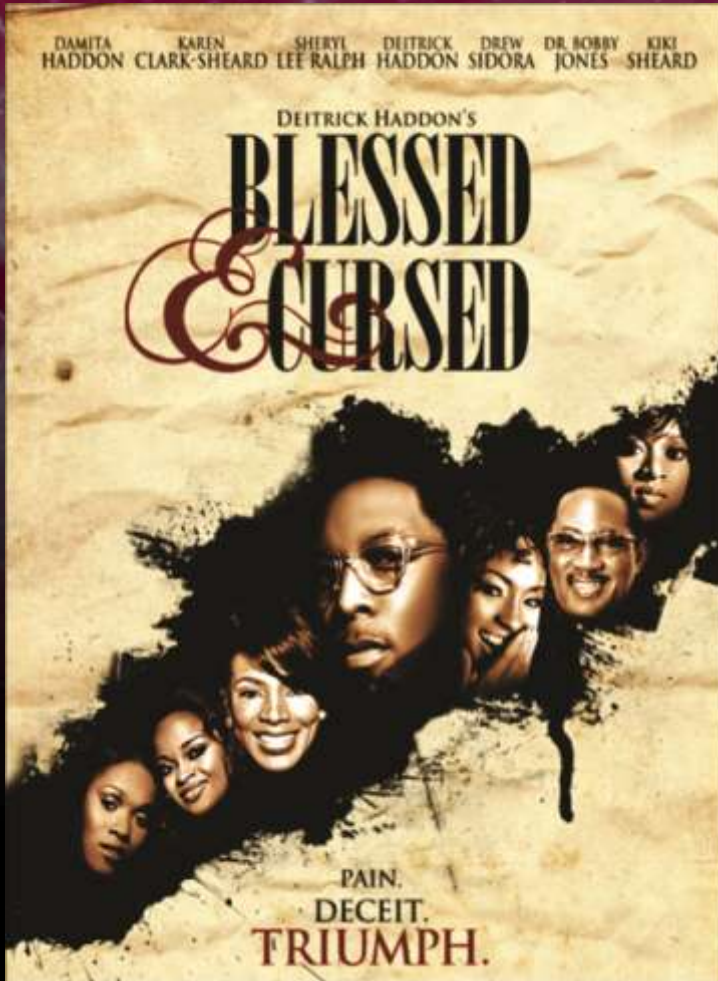


Dr. Michael Minder
