On June 25, 1865, pioneer missionary J. Hudson Taylor founded the China Inland Mission in Great Britain. The headquarters moved to the U.S. in 1901. In 1965, the organization changed its name to Overseas Missionary Fellowship. O.M.F. supports over 150 missionaries in 9 Southeast Asian and Pacific countries.
