This Week in Church History...

On August 17, 1761, William Carey, English missionary to India, was born. While still a teenager, he already could read the Bible in six languages. He joined the Baptist Church in 1783 and soon began advocating the cause of missions. In 1792, he preached the memorable sermon: *Expect Great Things from God; Attempt Great Things for God*. The following year he went to India as one of the first missionaries under the English Baptist Missionary Society. He became professor of Oriental languages at the newly founded Fort William College of Calcutta in 1801 and held the position the rest of his life. The Serampore Press, that Cary helped found, made the Bible accessible to more than 300,000,000 people.

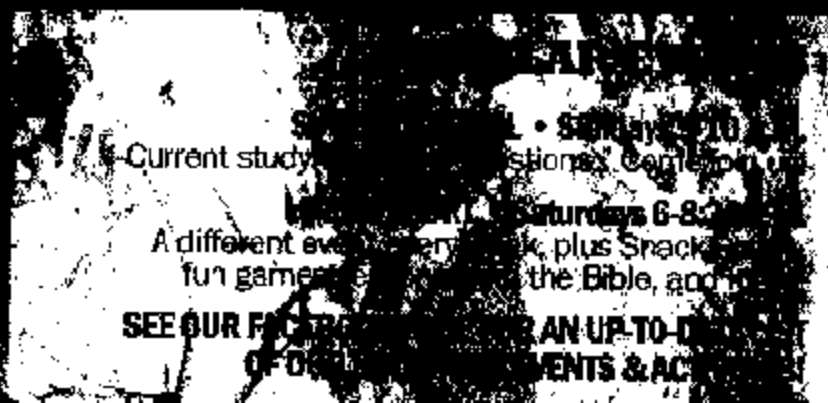
