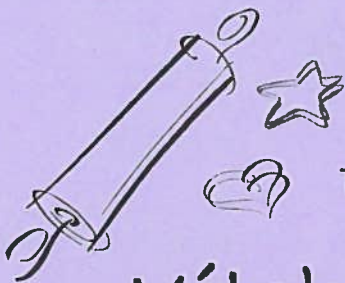

Bring food to share for the potluck and an unwrapped "gift" for the church kitchen.

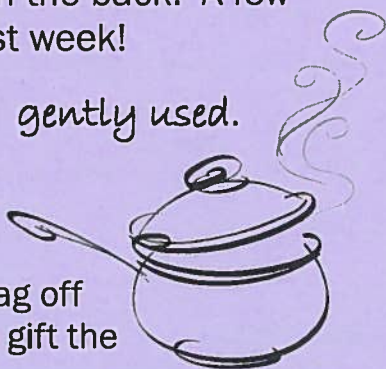
We have lots of events here at the church that use the kitchen and we need to have a well-stocked, functional kitchen.

## Utensils:

Tongs—metal and metal with rubber edges for serving & cooking (bacon specifically)

Dear Friends,

As I sat in the restaurant with a group of police detectives from Pueblo, CO Police Department I could sense the presence and power of God with us. As I asked each of the police officers about their relationship with Jesus and one of them, (Gabe) said he had not met Him yet. I asked Gabe if he wanted to and he said yes and prayed to receive Christ. I rejoiced that another soul was rescued from the kingdom of darkness and brought into the kingdom of Jesus Christ.

Over the past few months Gabe has grown in the Lord and joined an evangelical church with his wife. He told me everything in his life has changed. Other officers in the police department have been impacted by his testimony. Corey Purvis, who is a friend and a committed Christian has had an impact on the police department as a homicide detective. He has gone through difficult trials and has been a testimony to the power and presence of God in his life.

Together with Corey and other Christian officers we have been reaching out to the police in Pueblo. We have had 3 lunches where we have seen up to 15 officers attend and have shared the gospel and encouraged the Christian officers. The middle of March we will be having another outreach and are praying



Him do in Pueblo.

Most of our work has been in other countries but I am glad to have the opportunity to minister to police in this country as well. We plan to do outreaches among police in Colorado Springs and Denver in the coming months. Pray that many officers will attend and come to Christ as their Savior.

I preach the gospel to people everywhere I go in this country but seldom see people that are ready to follow Jesus. However, the seed is being planted and I believe that revival will come to the church in America and we will see a great harvest of souls in the years to come.

We continue to plan outreaches in other countries and are waiting for God to provide the funds we need to go and preach the gospel. Your faithful support and prayers have been a great encouragement to us and I rejoice in how God continues to encourage us as we wait upon Him and surrender our lives to Him in every way.

There are so many people who need the Lord and I love the prophetic word of God through Isaiah who said, *"I will say to the prisoners, Come out in Freedom, and to those in darkness, Come into the Light. They will be my sheep, grazing in green pastures and on hills that were previously bare". Isaiah 49:9*

May God use all of us to be His witnesses during these last days before the return of Christ. May the Lord continue to bless you in every way.
